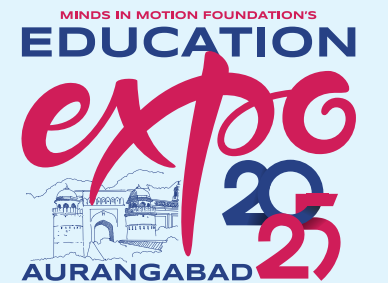
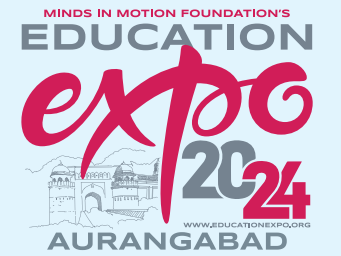

Public Speaking Competition :
